

Twin Peaks opens Clearview restaurant

The man cave/dining establishment Twin Peaks restaurant has opened its third Louisiana location in Metairie.

The restaurant and bar is located at the Clearview Mall at the former Serrano's Salsa Co. space.

The Dallas-based chain opened its first Louisiana location in Baton Rouge in 2011 and a second site in Houma in May.

The partners in the venture include Kyle Brechtel of Brechtel Ventures, New Orleans banker and businessman Gary Solomon and Kyle Crochet, who has managed various restaurant operations in the region.

Kristen Colby, Twin Peaks' senior director of marketing, said in an announcement that more than 150 new employees have been hired for the new locations. About 100 were brought on as Twin Peaks girls, the restaurant's main attraction, according to the statement.

The restaurant opens at 11 a.m. daily and closes at midnight Thursday, 2 a.m. Friday and Saturday and 11 p.m. Sunday.
